### **INTRODUCTION**

The NTC Foundation is seeking proposals from NTC Foundation residents to collaborate with fellow residents in creating a project, program or event to take place in 2020.

### **About ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station**

A burgeoning hub for life and culture in San Diego, ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station is a unique regional destination in the Point Loma neighborhood within the historic former Naval Training Center. It is home to galleries, museums, artists, studios and distinctive dining experiences. ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station is a destination where visitors can stroll the 100 park-like acres, discover something new each time and collect beautiful moments.

Many of the 38 historic buildings are now bursting with authenticity, creativity, heritage and innovation. Always changing and evolving, ARTS DISTRICT is a place to create, connect, learn, shop, dine, meet, explore and buy local art. From artists and dancers to boutique shops, a historic golf course, seasonal holiday ice rink, an array of community event venues, luxury cinemas, local restaurants and a public market, the ARTS DISTRICT abounds with entertainment, annual festivals and innovative cultural and culinary experiences.

### **ARTS DISTRICT GOALS**

GOALS for the ARTS DISTRICT are to be:

- 1) A Center for Arts, Culture & Creativity offering Innovative Experiences to residents and visitors;
- 2) A Creative Hub for San Diego's nonprofits, artists and creative businesses;
- 3) A Dynamic Destination for Children, Students, Residents, Visitors and Artists;
- 4) A Historic Showcase that honors our city's Heritage and this former Navy site

### **PROGRAM OPPORTUNITY DESCRIPTION**

*The Resident Group Collaborative Grant* is in its second year of providing funding to resident groups that collaborate to be creative.

Resident groups are asked to collaborate with as many fellow residents (with a minimum of two) to develop an innovative project, program or event that meets the goals of the ARTS DISTRICT. All projects, programs or events must take place within Liberty Station.

Resident groups will be responsible for marketing and promotion of their project, program and/or event. The NTC Foundation will conduct a meeting with grant recipient representatives to discuss support that will be provided regarding messaging and development of collateral. NTC Foundation requires all collateral, website copy etc. to be approved by the NTC Foundation prior to posting and collateral production/printing.

Proposals may be submitted in the amount of no less than \$2000 and no more than \$5000. The proposals can be a new or on-going project, a program, an event, or other. BE CREATIVE!

Projects require Resident Groups complete an agreement with the NTC Foundation and to submit a final report at the conclusion of their project, program or event. The final report will include a final budget, measurement data/statistics/analytics, quotes and photos.

We encourage all residents to participate. Listed below are NTC Foundation Resident Groups who can collaborate on a project, program or event. A minimum of two Resident Groups must be included in the collaboration.

Contracted amounts will be made in installments with the final installment to come after the final report has been submitted. All invoicing must be submitted during the 2020 calendar year.
